

While it is now time to prepare submission of papers by the end of this month, some of you expressed their worries as to know whether the conference could be held as planned in November in Agadir due to the COVID-19 international situation. We would like to reassure you that the organising committee and the scientific committee are considering this issue very seriously.

Three hypotheses are considered at this time:

1. To continue with the organization of MOSIM'20 as planned, assuming that international travels will be allowed from October and on.
2. To reschedule the dates of MOSIM'20 to the end of January or early February 2021, keeping in mind that CIGI Qualita is planned in May.
3. To set up an on-line conference on the rescheduled dates (as it is the case for other conferences or congresses).

For hypotheses 1 and 2, a mixed solution will be proposed to allow everyone to choose whether to participate/present in person or by videoconference. For online participation, the registration fees will be reduced.

The decision will be taken in August at the latest but, in any case, MOSIM'20 will be held.

It should be reminded that accepted papers will be published on the on-line open archive of CNRS (HAL) and that a significant number of papers will be selected to be published in partner journals of the conference (IJPR, CII and IJPLM).
